- 2. What are legitimate reasons for being single according to Matthew 19:10-12? What might be some other legitimate reasons for being single?
- 3. Why does our church need single people? (Look at 1 Corinthians 12:12-31)
- 4. In what ways can we better include each other at Forward? How can married people reach out to singles and vice versa?
- 5. As individual Christians and as a church where do we get our identity? (Galatians 2:20, Romans 6:1-11)
- 6. What does it mean to find our identity in Christ?
- 7. What are other things we can find our identity in that can distract us from this?
- 8. How does sinful living conflict with our identity in Christ?
- 9. Is it hard to accept that homosexuality is one of those sins? (Allow safety for honest discussion on this point.)
- 10. How can Christians who are same-sex attracted find their identity in Christ when they face the reality of this sin? How is that similar or different to any other Christian and their sins?
- 11. How can we as a church show love and support to Christians who are seeking to submit to Christ in this way?
- 12. How can we show love to unsaved homosexual people around us?
