- 1. Read Mark 15:1-39
- 2. What is an area of your life/situation in which you have a hard time trusting Christ? Why?
- 3. Does the truth that Jesus was in control even when He was crucified help you to trust Him more? Why or why not?
- 4. What do you think it means to love Jesus? What does it look like in your life?
- 5. Is it a struggle for you to love Jesus? What do you think causes the struggle? What distracts you from loving Jesus?
- 6. Does the truth that Jesus died to take the punishment for your sins help you to love Him more? Why or why not? If not, do you think it should help?
- 7. What does it look like to follow Jesus? What did Jesus mean in Mark 8:34-38?
- 8. What are some areas in which it is difficult for you to follow Jesus? What makes it hard?
- 9. Does the truth that Jesus died for you motivate you to follow Him? Why or why not?
- 10. What does it mean to worship Jesus? How does this relate to the other three (trust, follow, love)?
- 11. Are there things in your life that you sometimes put before Jesus? What can you do to remedy this?
- 12. Does the truth that Jesus died for you move you to worship Him and Him alone? Why or why not?
- 13. Remembering the gospel is the key to trusting, loving, following, and worshipping Jesus well. How can you keep the truth of the gospel, that Jesus died for your sins and rose again in the front of your mind and meditate on it?
