Evangelism – Romans 10:14-17

On Sunday, Nathan talked about being passionate. He said he was passionate about skateboarding and loved talking about it. What are some things that you are passionate about?

In Romans 10:1, Paul says that it's his heart's desire and prayer that his people be saved. He is passionate about sharing the gospel and seeing people saved. Where do you think this passion has come from?

Is this something that you are passionate about? (I'm not asking if you think you should be, but if you really are.) If you are passionate about it, why are you? If you aren't passionate about it, why do you think you aren't?

What can you do to develop that passion?

How much time do you spend thinking about the gospel and what it means for you? Do you think about it more or less than the other things you are passionate about?

Read the following passages, and discuss what they say about how incredible the gospel is: 2 Corinthians 5:17-21, 1 John 3:1-3, Romans 7:24-8:2, Romans 5:6-8, Colossians 2:9-15, Ephesians 2:1-9

Are there any other passages that you can think of that help you to dwell on the good news of the gospel?

Do you think that if you spent more time remembering the truth of the gospel, your passion would grow and you would be more excited about telling people? Why or why not?

Spend some time in prayer together, thanking God for the truth of the gospel, for how it has saved and changed you. Ask Him to give you a passion for the gospel that helps you share it with others.
